Items to give to your teacher:

- (2) Box of 24 #2 lead Pencils - please sharpen in advance! (Ticonderoga are best and replenish as needed)
- (1) Large Box of Kleenex
- (5) Baby wipes (we will share with the art classroom and the computer lab)
- (1) Ream of white copy paper

Items to bring for your desk and backpack:

- (1) 1 inch, 3-Ring Binder (We will set-up the binder in class)
- (2) Packages of white, college-ruled, binder notebook paper (replenish as needed)
- (1) 2-pocket folder, no brackets inside (homework folder)
