Welcome to 5th grade! We are eager to get to know you as we start the new school year. We have so many fun things planned for our students and families this year. We truly want 5th grade to be a family, so we are praying that you will come ready to grow as a whole class together this year. You will start your day in either 5A or 5B, but you will have each teacher for two core subjects. Mrs. Elliott will teach Math and Science, and Mrs. Vargas will teach History and Language Arts. We are excited to journey together with you as you become 5th graders!

Visitation Day is Friday, August 5, from 2:00 to 3:00 p.m. in the classrooms. The first full day of school is Monday, August 8. 5th Grade students will be dropped off on the upper campus in the drop off lane and can walk to the 5th Grade hallway.
